



Maps for Globe at Night latitude  $40^\circ$ , 2019-10-23, 21 h local time (Sun at  $-44^\circ$ ), transparent air. Lines from N(E,S,W) to zenith shown (crosses each  $10^\circ$ ). The map is centered on Markab ( $\alpha$  Pegasi), which is  $1^\circ$  to the right from S, at  $65^\circ$  height. Detailed maps  $50^\circ$  vertically, the first four maps  $100^\circ$ .
