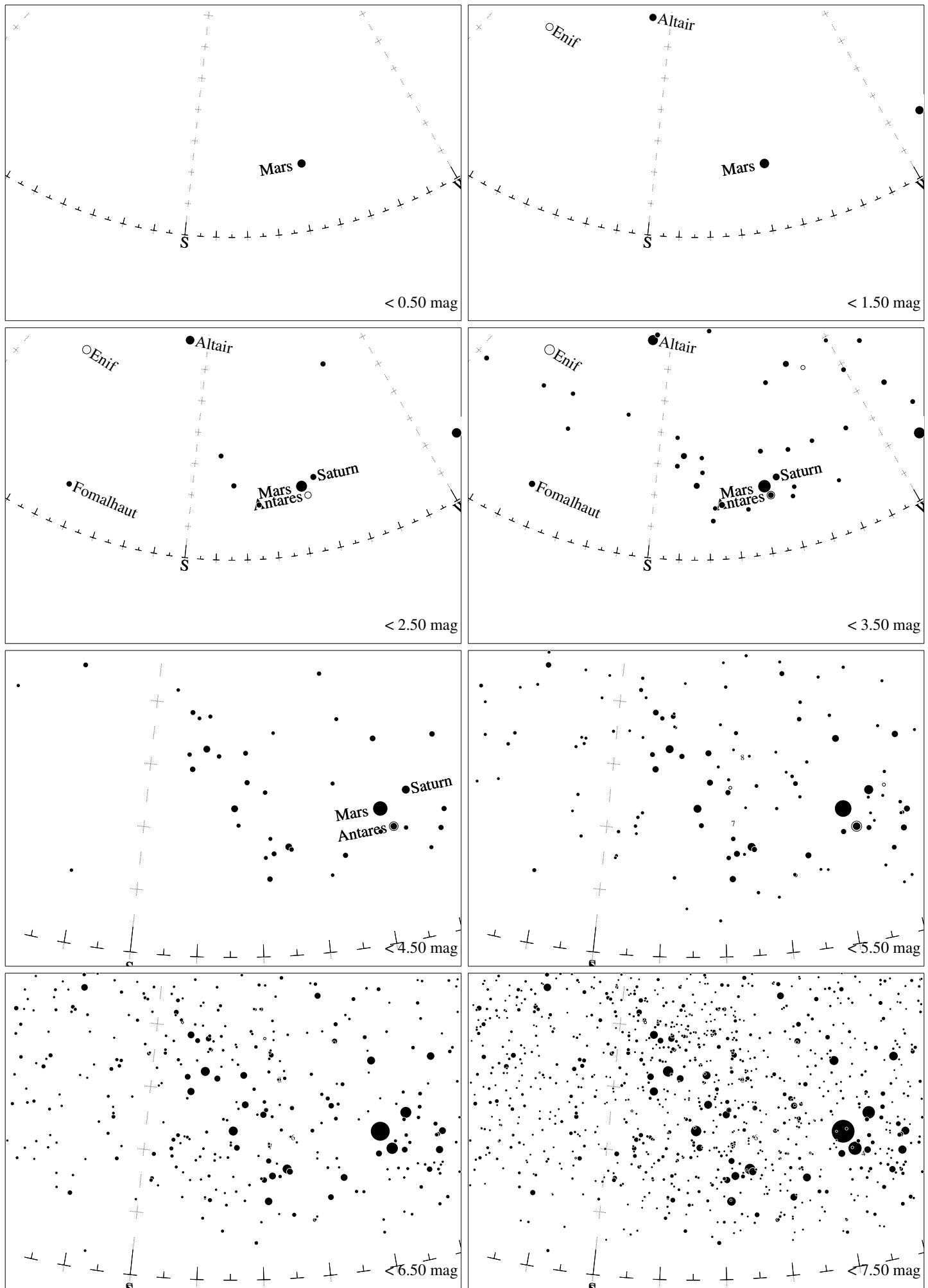

Centered on Kaus Australis ( $\epsilon$  Sagittarii), which is  $9^\circ$  to the left from S, at  $25^\circ$  height. Centered on Kaus Australis ( $\epsilon$  Sagitarii), which is  $15^\circ$  to the right from S, at  $24^\circ$  height.
